BY LAW NO. 33

WINTER PARKING BY-LAW

INTERPRETATION

- In this by-law, unless the context otherwise requires, 1.
 - words which are defined in Section 1 of the Motor Vehicle Act 1955 have the meaning as so defined for the purpsoes of this by-law.

RESTRICTED PARKING

In the months of December, January, February and March, between the hours of midnight and seven o'clock in the forenoon of any day, no person shall park a vehicle unattended on any highway within Chipman Village limits. 2.

IMPOUNDING OF VEHICLES

A peace officer may remove and impound any vehicle which is 3. found illegally parked on any highway, and no person shall take possession of a vehicle so removed or impounded until all costs and charges for, removal, care and storage of such vehicles have been paid.

PENALTIES

- Any person who violates any provision of this by-law is guilty 4. of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of not less than ten dollars and not more than fifty dollars.
- This by-law comes into force on the date of final passing 5. thereof.
